## Truth and Hospitality; Ethics for a Renewed Humanity

**What does it mean to be fully human?** Why is it important to speak the truth? Why should we protect the stranger? How can we act justly? How can we build a good society? These fundamental questions are at the heart of this introductory course in theological ethics.

**This course seeks to develop an** appreciation for the centrality of ethical inquiry in human life and society. The critical study of the work of various theological ethicists will introduce participants to a range of approaches and methods in contemporary theological ethics. The practical examination of questions of racism and refugee protection will encourage participants to hone their own distinctive ethical voice.

We aim to make theological education accessible to a wide range of students. This is a rich opportunity for those seeking deeper understanding of Christian faith and spiritual enrichment; and/or wanting to pursue graduate theological education without earning a degree; and/or thinking about ordained ministry, but wanting to discern a call by trying some courses first.
