Course work requirements:

- 1 3-credit course in Mission
- 1 3-credit course in Preaching
- 1 2-credit course in Education and Formation
- 1 2-credit course in Leadership
- 1 2-credit course Pastoral Care
- 2 3-credit courses in Denominational Studies

Field work

- The equivalent of 4 3-credit courses (12 credits) in a Field Placement, including attendance at field education group session, completion of theological reflections, and other matters in purview of Directors of Studies

Other requirements

- 1 day-long workshop on preaching
- 1 day-long workshop on conflict management
- 1 day-long workshop on pastoral care
- Completion of Integrative Papers
- Completion of an Inter-cultural Experience
- Completion of "College Focus" blocks to the satisfaction of the college

Teaching (for information)

- 1 ½ day orientation at the beginning of the Academic Year.
- Maintain an every-week teaching schedule, with 12 weeks of class per term. In each class week there are also hours dedicated to the Field placement. There are also three weeks in the year set aside for Field Placement only. For a total of 14 weeks of class and placement per term.
- Intensive week-long classes have been removed from the program schedule.
